

## Recording Video to JBOD VideoXpert Professional (VxPro) Systems


On initial configuration, your VxPro JBOD system will record all cameras to a single drive. You must add your additional JBOD drives to a volume group through the VxStorage interface to record using the full capacity of your JBOD system.

The VxStorage interface for VxPro will distribute cameras across the default volume group — a grouping of disks across which cameras and recorded video are distributed. However, when you configure VxPro, the volume group will contain only the first, non-OS drive.


## Adding and Arranging JBOD Volumes

Perform this processes after you configure your VxPro server.

1. On the VxPro server, open a supported browser, type `https://127.0.0.1` in the address field, and then press Enter.  
Supported browsers are the current versions of Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, or Microsoft Edge.
2. When prompted about a potential security risk, click **Advanced**, and then click **Accept the Risk and Continue**.
3. Log in to VxPortal with the user name `admin` and the password you set when configuring VxPro.
4. In the upper-right corner, click **admin**, and then click **Configure Server**.



5. Log in to the VideoXpert Storage Portal using the same credentials you used to login to VxPortal.
6. Click the **Volumes** tab.
7. Add drives/volumes to the Default Volume Group.
  - a. Click the add icon (+) under *Volumes*, and then type the *Path* of a drive you want to add to the recorder. Use the format `X:\ProServer\Recordings`.



- b. (Optional) Enter the *Buffer Size*—the percentage of space on the drive you want to reserve for non-VxPro activity.
- c. Click **OK**.
- d. Repeat these steps until you have added all JBOD volumes to the volume group.
